FAUNA SIMALURENSIS.

Ixodidae.

Six small tubes of ticks collected in 1913 by Mr. E. JACOBSON in Simalur and Pulu Babi (¹) were submitted to me for identification. They were found to contain two species of *Haemaphysalis*; one of *Dermacentor*, one of *Amblyomma* and one of *Aponomma*, all of them forms already known. Most of the specimens belong to the species *Amblyomma helvolum* C. L. Koch, which, according to L. E. ROBINSON, who has recently revised the genus, has the following synonyms: — *decoratum* C. L. Koch., *fimbriatum* C. L. Koch., *furcosum* NEUM., *quadrimaculatum* NEUM. and *tenimberense* HIRST. It was taken from various reptiles. Subjoined is a list of the tubes and their contents.
